

Unique, set at the top of one of the most beautiful villages in France, this remarkable castle was built in the 14th century overhanging the rock and enjoys an exceptional panoramic view of the valley. it is composed of different buildings built over time and its outbuildings, keeper's house, barn, stables, garage. A high fortified gate gives access to the beautiful inner courtyard and its garden with swimming pool.

The main building has beautiful architectural elements, large stone staircase, several monumental fireplaces, beautiful doors, mullioned or geminated windows, floors in Versailles parquet or walnut ladders, beautiful reception rooms, including a large living room of 80 m², Louis XVI living room, library, large dining room, 7 bedrooms, one of which benefits from the large terrace of 80 m² and its breathtaking view over the valley. A unique place.

THE CASTLE

Ground floor 352 m²

Entrance hall with large stone staircase 32,05 m². Wooden entrance door with 2 wings and glass transom, stone floor, large stone staircase in gallery on the first floor height under ceiling 6.37 m, 2 windows illuminate the staircase hall.

Living room Louis XVI : 36,96 m² 1 marble fireplace, a window on the north side Ladder Parquet floor in walnut, cupboard,

1st Floor East Wing

Gallery landing, 18.20 m² Stone floor, illuminated by 2 wooden windows, a fixed bay, a wooden glazed door to access the covered terrace

Terrace 25,34 m²

The terrace is covered with a roof whose beautiful framework is supported on stone corbels with coats of arms and 5 stone columns.

Stone floor, stone staircase leading down to the main courtyard

Circulation 08,98 m² Corridor which serves the toilets and the room 2

Room 2 : 36,08 m² monumental stone fireplace, 1 double mullioned window, interior wooden shutters Carpeted floor on oak parquet

Toilet 02,94 m² Window in the arrow-and musket-slits

Large suite (room 3) 43,49 m² Marble fireplace with trumeau decorated with 3 mirrors, a large window with double mullions, parquet floor panneauté Versailles. A glass door gives access to the large terrace

Bathroom 08,82 m bath, shower, washbasin, WC, bidet, a window, parquet floor

Dressing room 04,25 m

Large Terrace 82,00 m Overlooking the courtyard and open to the valley, it offers an exceptional panoramic view, at the north-east corner a tower, a door in the tower allows access by a stone staircase, to the main courtyard
